Reserving allways to me my liferent of the primities  
and full pour liberty to alter and Innovate these  
presents in whole or in part but in case of no Alteration  
Thereby declare the same to be valid and sufficient  
altho found in my custody or in the custody of any  
other person undur'd the time of my death and  
law to the Contrary notwithstanding wherewith I for  
me and my heirs dispence forever Consenting to the  
registration hereof in the Books of Council & Session  
or others competent therein to remain for preservation  
and thereto I Constitute
